o.camp is a learning camp that takes place in the Easter holidays. Here, pupils can catch up on important schoolwork in one of the three key subjects: German, maths or English. As well as this, the children work on a project and can take part in a variety of activities during their free time. The programme is directed at young people who are having difficulty learning and whose progress into school year 9 is at risk. Pupils in year 8 at Hauptschulen, Realschulen or Gesamtschulen can take part.



## When and where does o.camp take place?

o.camp takes place in the Easter holidays, from **26.03.-06.04.2018**. Accommodation is provided in a well-equipped youth hostel. Participants are driven to and from the hostel by bus. Participation in the camp costs 50 EUR all inclusive.

## How can my child apply?

To take part in *o.camp*, your child must complete an application form. You can pick up a copy of the form from our website <a href="www.ocamp.de">www.ocamp.de</a>. You can also pick up the form at school. Please ask for a form a class teacher of your child or a social worker at school. The completed and signed form must be returned to the school by end of January. You can also send the form by **09.02.2018** at the latest to the Hessian Ministry of Culture by yourself.
